The successful candidate will have a strong interest in Pediatric Otolaryngology and a preference for incorporating pediatric ENT into a broad general otolaryngology practice. - Eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- Specialist Certification in Otolaryngology
- A strong interest in Pediatric Otolaryngology and general otolaryngology
- Fellowship training, additional experience, or a focused practice in Pediatric Otolaryngology is preferred but not required
- Eligibility for a faculty appointment with NOSM University
- A commitment to supporting the academic mandate of the Otolaryngology Service through teaching and mentorship

This is an excellent opportunity for an Otolaryngologist who wants to build a rewarding pediatric-focused practice while maintaining a broad general ENT practice, within a supportive tertiary-care and academic environment serving Northern Ontario.
