Seniors' Transportation Program

The Seniors' Transportation Program of the Canadian Red Cross assists seniors to be independent by providing dependable, low-cost, door to door transportation within the City of Greater Sudbury.

Support for the Seniors' Transportation Program has been provided by the North East Local Health Integration Network (NE LHIN) and the Government of Ontario, United Way, local fundraising projects and a user fee that is charged to the client to partially offset the cost of providing the program.

Services are provided by volunteer drivers using their own vehicles or a Canadian Red Cross vehicle. Normal hours of operation are 8:30am – 5:00pm Monday to Friday.

Transportation service may be extended beyond these hours and on weekends depending on the availability of drivers.







Who Qualifies?

Individuals who:

- Are 60 years and over.
- Are not living in a Long Term Care Facility.
- Must be able to transfer in and out of a vehicle independently or may bring an escort to assist with their needs.
- Are unable to access existing transportation options (transit) and not currently driving.

Fees for Services

Fees depend on the geographical area of the client's pick up and drop off locations.

The Canadian Red Cross mails an invoice to the client each month for services provided. Fees can be paid by credit card, money orders, or cheque.

No money is exchanged between the client and the volunteer driver.

Service is dependent on volunteer availability.
