Diabetes Care Service Program Criteria and Description

Pediatric Program:

- Children aged 0-18 years with pre-diabetes, Type 1 diabetes or Type 2 diabetes
- Includes team of RNs, dietitians, social workers and pediatricians to support children with diabetes and their families
- Referral required from Physician or Nurse Practitioner

Adult Program:

- Adults with diabetes
- Includes individual appointments with diabetes educators and/or allied health care including social workers
- Includes group classes
- Endocrinologist assessment requires referral from Physician or Nurse Practitioner

Insulin Pump Program:

- Adults and children with Type 1 diabetes who have or may be eligible for an insulin pump.
- Includes individual and group sessions with RN, dietitian, social worker and endocrinologist
- Referral required from Physician or Nurse Practitioner

Gestational Program:

- Pregnant women with gestational diabetes or pre-existing Type 1 diabetes or Type 2 diabetes
- Individual sessions with RN, dietitian, social worker and internist to help manage diabetes throughout pregnancy and in the antenatal period
- Referral required from Physician, Obstetrician, Midwife or Nurse Practitioner

Center for Complex Diabetes Care:

- Adults with diabetes who have complications and/or co-morbidities and who would benefit from an intensive diabetes management program and are agreeable to attending multiple appointments; patients will be triaged according to program criteria and patient need
- Individual sessions with a RN, dietitian, pharmacist, social worker, physiotherapist, endocrinologist
- Chiropodists available for patients with diabetic foot ulcers/ wounds
- Nurse practitioners available for patients who do not have a primary care provider
- Referral required from Physician or Nurse Practitioner
