## **Getting to the Cancer Center**

### **Transportation Assistance**

#### **Northern Health Travel Grant**

If you will travel more than 100 kilometers, you may be eligible for a Northern Health Travel Grant. Your primary care provider in your home community will know about this program. They will be able to give you an application form. Please present the grant form to the clerk when you register so that it can be signed by the doctor.

#### **Canadian Cancer Society Wheels of Hope Program**

If you require a ride to the cancer center you can contact the Canadian Cancer Society Wheels of Hope program. Volunteer drivers can help patients with travelling to cancer related appointments. New patients who register for the volunteer driver program will be required to pay an annual registration fee. To register or for more information call 1-800-263-6750

#### **Handi-Transit**

### **Accommodations**

#### **Daffodil Terrace Lodge**

If you live more than 40 kilometers from the Centre you may be able to stay in the Daffodil Terrace Lodge; a fee will apply. You can bring and make your own food or buy food from the Hospital food services. You may be eligible for an allowance from the Northern Health Travel Grant. The Lodge is physically

attached to the Cancer Centre. Please call the Daffodil Terrace Lodge in advance of your appointment at 1 (800) 465-6343.

## Parking

All cancer care services are provided in the Northeast Cancer Centre building at the Ramsey Lake Health Centre site of Health Sciences North. The main entrance to the Northeast Cancer Centre faces Ramsey Lake Road and Science North. Parking is available at many lots around the Hospital.

The parking lot in front of the Cancer Centre (P6), is a pay and display lot. For all other parking lots, please ensure you **BRING YOUR PARKING TICKET INSIDE AND PAY AT A PAY STATION INSIDE HSN.**
